Before you agree to any images or audio recordings of you being used by the GTNT Group, there are some important things you need to know.

What will happen to my images once they are taken?

GTNT Group will store your images digitally in its photographic library database. The talent release form that you signed will be filed with your images. Once stored in the database, your images may be used by GTNT Group for a wide variety of purposes, ongoing, until advised otherwise by you in writing.

Where will my images or audio be used?

Your images may be used in a variety of applications. Some of the typical places could include printed brochures and flyers, newspaper advertising, magazines and journals, television commercials, radio commercials, events and displays, newsletters, websites and social media channels, outdoor billboards and banners, bus advertising and others as required. Your image may be used in situations that are unrelated to the original purpose for which they were taken.

What if I don't want my photograph to be used somewhere?

It can be quite a surprise to see your photograph blown up two metres tall at a display, or to suddenly find yourself appearing on television. You need to be aware that your photograph may be used in these situations unless you ask for it not to be. If there are circumstances where you do not want your photo used, make sure you write that down on the Talent Release Form you sign.

Scholarship Conditions

Conditions

1. Applications. You must submit a completed Scholarship Application Form, agreeing to the Scholarship Conditions and all supporting documentation by the advertised closing date (or any later closing date subsequently advised to applicants by the RTO).

2. Individual Applications. Applications submitted jointly by more than one person may be considered. Scholarships are generally awarded to an individual and may be shared. *(If permission by the RTO is granted)*

3. Refused applications. If Your Application is received after the closing date or does not meet the requirements set out in these conditions it will not be considered.

4. Applications not returned. Your Application will not be returned and will become the property of the GTNT Group and ISTA

5. Application costs. You must meet all Your costs associated with applying for the Scholarship.

- 6. Scholarships on offer.** ISTA may cancel any of the Scholarships on offer, whether or not advertised, or reduce their advertised value. You will be advised of any cancellation or variation and where any aspect of a Scholarship has been varied will be asked if You wish to continue with Your application.
- 7. Eligibility criteria.** To be eligible for a Scholarship, You must be eligible to study in Australia for the full duration of the enrolled course.
- 8. No age restriction.** Applicants must be 18 years or older.
- 9. Place and Duration of Study.** The Scholarships are for study in Darwin, Northern Territory in the ISTA training facilities. The scholarship is for the duration of the course.
- 10. Leave.** You must apply for leave through the RTO administrator for the duration of the Scholarship. Failing to do so may result in the cancellation of your Scholarship and/or the remainder of course fees to be billed to You on a pro rata basis.
- 11. Proposed study.** Subject to the specific requirements of an advertised Scholarship, You must undertake study and adhere to the conditions of the course.
- 12. Payment of Scholarships.** The Scholarship funds are for the course tuition only. All other costs are the responsibility of the Scholarship recipient.
- 13. Tax.** ISTA cannot give You advice on any tax consequences of receipt of Scholarship funds. You may wish to seek Your own advice.
- 14. No deferral.** Unless otherwise approved by the RTO manager, You must commence Your study by the date specified. A later commencement date will only be granted in exceptional circumstances.
- 15. No transfer.** The Scholarship is not transferable.
- 16. Information requests.** You must comply with reasonable requests by the RTO for additional information and documentation and provide any required information together with documentation by the dates requested.
- 17. Passports and visas.** You are responsible for obtaining all necessary passports, visas and other documentation.
- 18. Insurance.** You are responsible for your own insurances.
- 19. Conduct whilst on Scholarship.** Whilst a beneficiary of the Program You will make every reasonable endeavour to:
1. at all times be a good ambassador for International Students and ISTA;
 2. avoid any act (including making any oral or written communication) that could damage the sponsor's reputation, be misleading, result in victimisation or harassment, lead to criminal or civil liability, or be reasonably found to be offensive, obscene, threatening, abusive or defamatory; and
 3. comply with all laws, rules, regulations, policies and standards applicable studying in Australia.
- 20. Copyright licence.** You hereby grant a non-exclusive, royalty-free copyright licence to ISTA to exercise and sub-licence all rights of copyright (including rights to reproduce the work and

communicate it to the public) in any material produced by You that is funded by the Scholarship (with or without amendment) for any non-commercial purpose. This licence includes, without limiting its generality, permission to post material or parts of it on the ISTA's website.

21. Promotion of the Program. You are expected to provide support to ISTA and the Northern Territory in publicising and promoting the Program, including participation in media interviews. You may, for example, be requested to make presentations in relation to Your experiences. ISTA may request a copy of any material that You wish to release referring to the Program, for their prior approval. You must comply with any such request and comply with any conditions of approval.

You hereby consent to the publication and/or use in any form of media of Your name and/or Your photo and/or any material that You have produced that has been funded by the Scholarship for the purpose of publicising the Program without payment or compensation.

22. Withdrawal from Scholarship. You must immediately notify the RTO manager of any decision to withdraw from the Program.

2. Cancellation of your Visa;
3. other circumstances beyond Your control that prevent You from pursuing study.

General Information

23. Non-award of Scholarships. ISTA may, upon recommendation of the panel not award any or all of the Scholarships in a given year if they decide (in their absolute discretion) either that there are no suitable applicants for the Scholarships or that there are insufficient applications.

24. Feedback. Successful applicants will be informed by a representative of the RTO. Unsuccessful applicants will be informed by email.

25. Exceptions. These Scholarship Conditions are standard for all applicants. However, exceptions may be granted to applicants based on their individual needs and circumstances.

26. Subject to change. These Scholarship Conditions are subject to change at any time without prior notice.
